“Innovative tools for the validation of competencies in volunteering”

Rome, Italy, 23rd -27th October 2017

Logistical information

Arrival date: participant should arrive on Sunday 22nd of October (at any time)

Departure date: participants can leave Rome in the afternoon of Friday 27th October. If they prefer, they can also stay overnight and leave on Saturday 28th of October.

Costs: all costs for the training will be pay by VOYCE project: travel, accommodation, and meals.

Accommodation: Hostel Marelo, via Urbana 50, Rome. It is very central, in the heart of Rome historical center and 5 minutes by walk from Colosseum. It is a basic accommodation: a hostel with double rooms, shared bathroom, second floor without elevator.

About the course

VOYCE project:

This training is part of the VOYCE project, co-financed by the EU – Erasmus+ program

Today in Europe more than 1 young person out of 5 carries out volunteering activities. These are very formative experiences that can enhance the competences of young people and their employability. Unfortunately, the practical tools for validating these competencies are still unsuitable, and the young people themselves tend to underestimate this issue.

The VOYCE project brings together 8 organizations from 5 European countries with the common goal of building innovative tools to validate the competences of young volunteers. Particular attention is paid to young people with fewer opportunities.

The training course

The training course will be addressed to a group of 25 youth workers from Italy, France, Spain, Portugal, Poland. The course will have a duration of 5 days and will be held in English language.

Participants will have the opportunity to learn how to use 2 experimental tools for the validation of young volunteers' competencies:

- Manual: the manual will be a practical tool used by organizations that host young volunteers to bring out and validate the learning acquired by them;
- On line platform: the interactive platform will offer the opportunity to carry out also on a digital support the pathway already established in the manual. Moreover the platform will offer features to promote connections between young people and companies.

The training will make an extensive use of methodologies of active education. The idea is to make the youth workers experience the same techniques and group dynamics they will likely apply with young volunteers.
