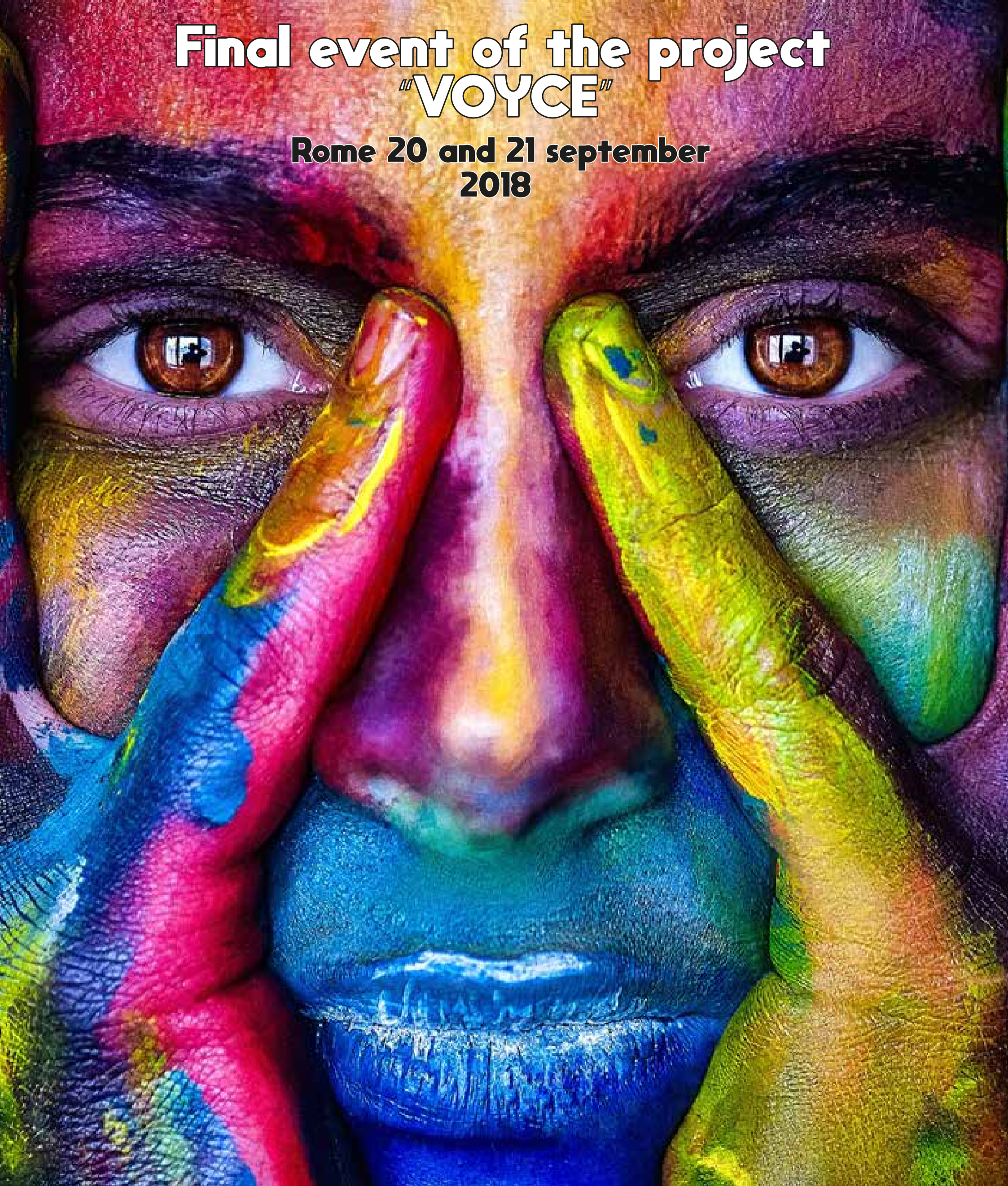


Final event of the project "VOYCE"
